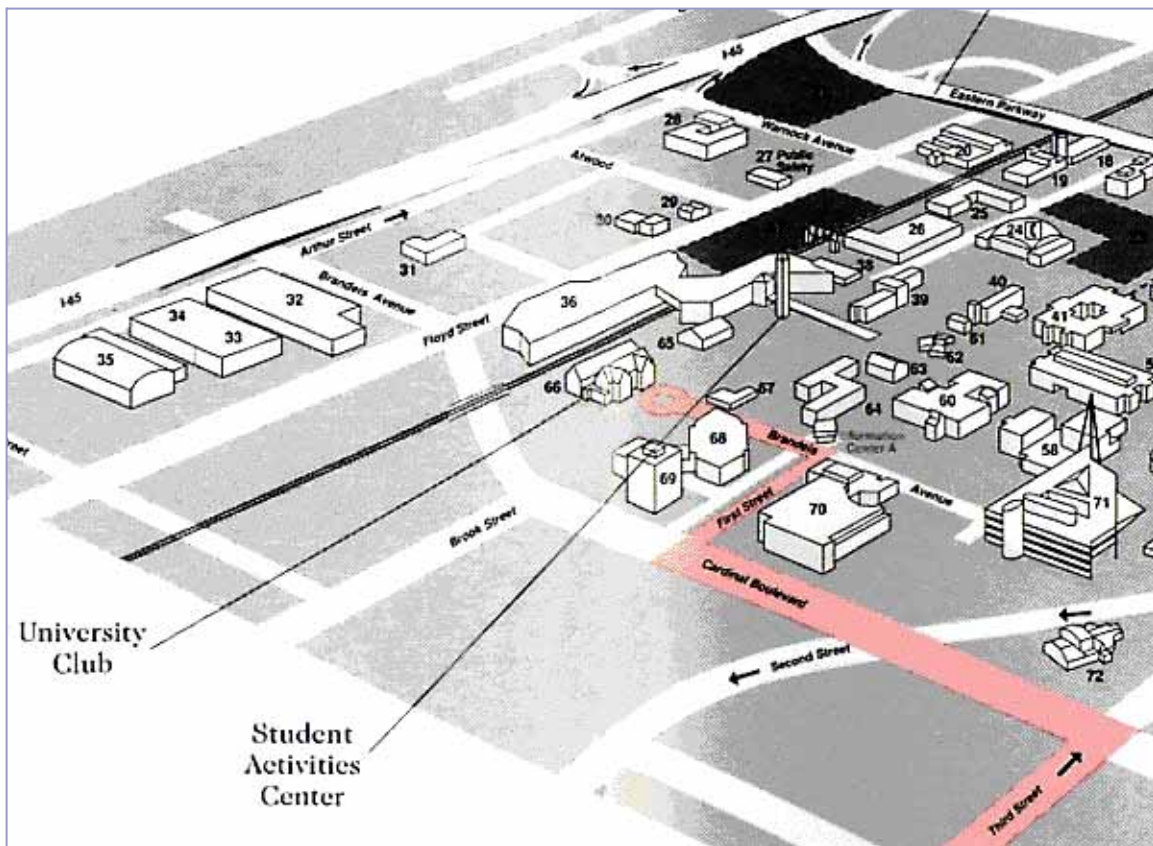

Women For Habitat Needs Volunteers

Women For Habitat, a subcommittee of Habitat For Humanity of Metro Louisville, needs your help. We are seeking volunteers to help with construction and fund raising. Absolutely no experience is necessary. We train on the job. Our houses are exceptional, because our homes are built primarily by women.

The Women For Habitat mission states: We believe everyone deserves a decent, affordable place to live. It is our mission to empower women from all walks of life to make a difference in the housing crisis facing families and individuals in our community by: Recruiting women and training them with construction skills; thereby instilling them with confidence in their abilities; Raising the nec-

essary funds required to build houses; Building houses with primarily women volunteers; Contributing to the affiliate's overall volunteer resource needs. Now is the time we need your commitment as we begin our 14th home!

You may sign up individually, or recruit your own crew with family, friends, church members or co-workers. (For safety and liability reasons, children under the age of 16 are not allowed on the construction site, and teens that are 16-18 years old must have an accompanying adult.)

As you can see, our greatest need is on week days. Simply contact me to let me know which date(s) you'd like to work, and, if you plan to bring others, how many people you would like to bring for these dates: -Raise the Roof:

Wednesday, May 19, Thursday, May 20, and Friday, May 21 (We need twelve of the 24 volunteers working May 19, 20 and May 21 to be willing to work on ladders and on the roof.) - Thursday(s): June 10, 17, 24; July 1, 8, 15, 29; Aug. 5, 12, 26 -Saturday(s): Aug.7, 28.

Please keep in mind that our construction schedule is based on you being there for the entire shift-- from 8:30 to 3:30. We depend upon you to arrive on time for introductions, instructions, and job assignments, and stay for clean up. We do not have half-day shifts.

As soon as you know your schedule and plans, please contact MaryAbbott@Bellsouth.net Cell: 550-4528. After we confirm your work date(s), I'll send you a Welcome Packet with direc-

tions and other pertinent information.

CONFERENCE REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registration is required for any member attending any event scheduled as part of the State Conference. In an effort to control costs, KFBPW is asking members to wear your own local BPW name badge which will serve as your pass to conference activities. Blank name tags will also be available to registrants at the KFBPW registration desk.

Registration time shall be from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. Friday and 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday. Credentials must be presented at the registration desk prior to 4:00 p.m. Friday, June 11, 2010, to establish a quorum. Registration for voting shall close at 10 a.m. on Saturday. All registered KFBPW members in good standing and who have paid their registration fee are eligible to vote in the business session. Guests are welcome to attend and speak, but cannot vote.

Early bird registration is available until May 1st. All registrations postmarked after May 31st must include a late fee of \$20.00.

INTERIM BOARD CONFERENCE HOTEL

Barren River Lake State Resort Park is located at 1149 State Park Road, Lucas, KY 42156-9709; 15 miles southwest of Glasgow and 44 miles southeast of Bowling Green.

The lodge was built in 1972 and renovation of all lodge rooms was completed in 2007. All rooms have an outside entrance and a balcony. There are 49 rooms with 2 queen beds and 3 rooms with a single king bed.

All lodge rooms are complete with hair dryers, irons and ironing boards. Other amenities include: soap, shampoo, and coffee pots with John Conti Bluegrass Blend Coffee. The lodge offer free wireless internet access from lodge public areas, lodge rooms and meeting rooms.

Before founding Advancement Strategies, Laura served as the Secretary of Education for the commonwealth of Kentucky, and before that as Commissioner for Workforce Investment, a position responsible for the oversight of 2300 employees and a budget of nearly 1 billion dollars

Her commitment has been noted at both the state and national levels where she has received appointments from Governor Paul Patton and Governor Ernie Fletcher, as well as serving on a White House commission at the invitation of two presidents, President George W. Bush and President Barack Obama.

Prior to her current position, Laura served in a variety of other roles: teacher, writer, TV host, and an elected city official.

She has recently published a book: *Thank You for Blue Horses: Lessons I Have Learned from My Children* with a second book: *Becoming the Red Sock in the Laundry Basket: Simple Strategies to Everyday Leadership* due out this year.

Laura lives in Frankfort with her husband Donnic. She has two children and two brilliant grandchildren.
