April is a month full of fun and exciting things for BPW!

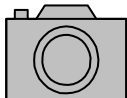
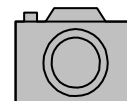

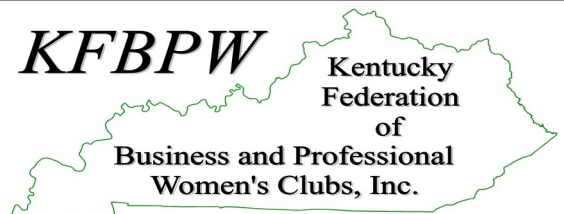

We can go to her in times of joy to sit and share a laugh*

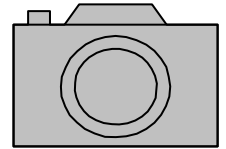
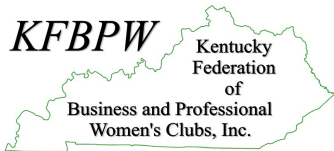
