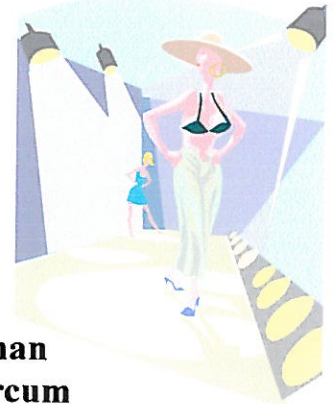

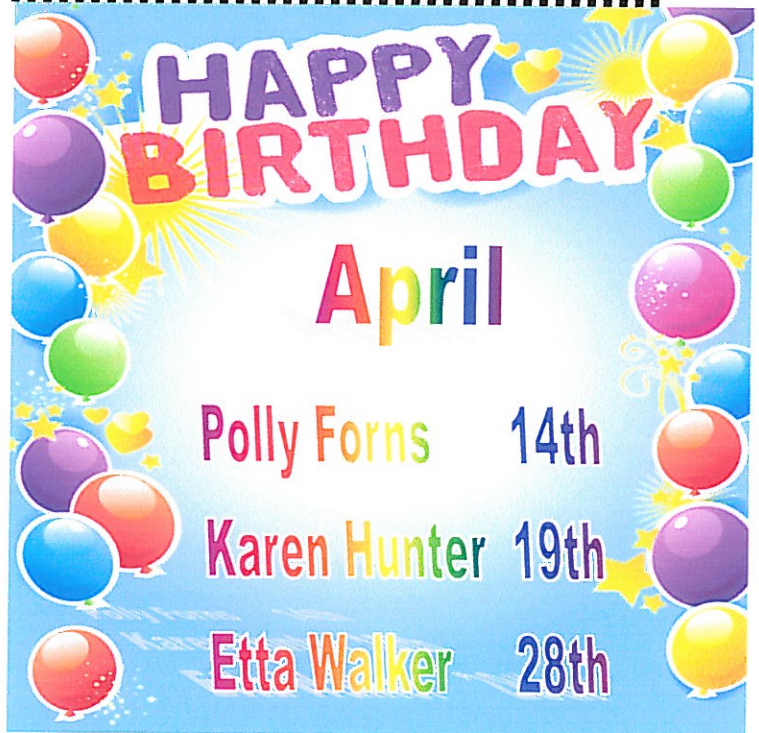
Board Meetings

**Meeting Place**

*This was originally part of the President's Message but due to space was made a separate article.*

The one subject that is on everyone's mind is the meeting place and prices of meals. The Pioneers is \$11.00 for a meat, two vegetables, salad, dessert, bread and drink and decorations by Glynn and Diane. The Homestead is \$10.00 including tip. You can select a meat, two vegetables, salad, bread and drink. As of April 5<sup>th</sup> I talked with Barbara, she cannot give us a dessert for the \$10 price, because she has added one dollar to the price of meals since our first conversation. If you still want to meet at the Homestead it would be \$11.00 including dessert. She stated that a slice of pie is usually 2.50. She does have a blue plate special for \$6.90 Also, if fish is ordered add one dollar. She is still working on her revised menu. We could not decorate because sometimes there would be a meeting in the room one hour prior to our arrival and if the room was needed for a larger group we would be moved to a smaller room. If we ordered from the menu we could get a copy before our meeting, write your name on it and turn it in as we enter and the meal should be ready when we are finished with our meeting. Both locations stated that food prices have gone up.

At the December 2010 Board Meeting a discussion was held in regards to the club losing money each month on meals. At that time the Pioneers had a minimum requirement of 25 each month that number has since been changed to 20. A special committee was appointed to see if there was another location to hold the meetings and to also talk with the Pioneers about what they could do. It was at that time the required number was lowered to 20 and the cost changed to \$11. The fact that the club is paying out additional money most months for meals is the reason the special committee was asked to see if there was an alternative.
